

# CODE OF CONDUCT

## Dundee High School Marching Band Camp 2020-2021

**Dundee High School Rules** As a school sponsored activity, all school district rules, regulations, and penalties as specified in the Dundee High School Student Handbook will be in effect at all times during the week of Marching Pre-Camp & Band Camp.

1. "Student Dress" code will be in effect while at camp. All clothes must be of a tasteful manner. No profanity. No bare midriffs or excessively low-cut tops will be allowed.
2. No threats, confrontation, harassment, hazing, bullying, aggressive behavior, or physical violence will be tolerated.

**Respect** is earned and is never just given AND you must give respect to receive respect. Meaning when you interact with an individual you treat them with dignity and in a respectful manner as this shows your character as a person. You must always behave in a respectful manner as this reflects on you, your character, integrity and values of who you are as a person.

3. Language should always be of an acceptable nature. No disrespectful, abusive, or obscene language.
4. When in doubt if an action you are contemplating is appropriate, consult a parent chaperone or the Band Director for advice first.

**Visiting / Leaving Marching Band Camp** No guests will be allowed at camp. We are attending camp to get a job done and must concentrate on it.

Students are not to leave camp at any time, for any reason without expressed permission of the Band Director. If you are given permission to leave camp, you must be signed out/in by an authorized parent/guardian with the Marching Band Director.

### Marching Band Camp Expectations

5. Students must attend band camp in its entirety. Please do not plan any activity that will interfere with the marching band camp schedule.
6. Students must be on time to all rehearsals. Disciplinary action will be administered if necessary.
7. Students must attend lunch in the area designated and they are required to eat at meals and drink plenty of water throughout the day.
8. No students will be allowed outside of the designated band camp areas without individual permission from the Band Director or Parent Chaperone. Any student caught in unauthorized areas or leaving camp premises (school grounds) will be immediately sent home which may result in dismissal from the DHS band program.
9. If you have a cell phone with you at camp **it must remain in your backpack or instrument case during all rehearsals, meals, and group activities. Cell phones may be used during individual rec time.** If you are found using your cell phone at times other than designated it will be confiscated for the remainder of that day and must be turned in to the Band Director at the beginning of each consecutive day.
10. Students must adhere to all instructions/requirements pertaining to mask wearing and social distancing. Noncompliance will result in being sent home from band camp and potentially dismissed from the marching band program.
