CODE OF CONDUCT

Dundee High School Marching Band Camp 2024-2025

Dundee High School Rules As a school sponsored activity, all school district rules, regulations, and penalties as specified in the Dundee High School Student Handbook will be in effect at all times during the week of Marching Band Camp.

- 1. "Student Dress" code will be in effect while at camp. All clothes must be of a tasteful manner. No profanity. No bare midriffs or excessively low cut tops will be allowed, including swim wear.
- 2. No threats, confrontation, harassment, hazing, bullying, aggressive behavior or physical violence will be tolerated.
- 3. Luggage will not be searched. However, if for any reason there are reasonable grounds to believe the student has violated federal, state, or local law or school rules a luggage and/or room search will result.

Respect is earned and is never just given AND you must give respect to receive respect. Meaning when you interact with an individual you treat them with dignity and in a respectful manner as this shows your character as a person. You must always behave in a respectful manner as this reflects on you, your character, integrity and values of who you are as a person.

- 4. Language should always be of an acceptable nature. No disrespectful, abusive, or obscene language.
- 5. When in doubt if an action you are contemplating is appropriate, consult a parent chaperone or the Band Director for advice first.

Visiting / Leaving Marching Band Camp No guests will be allowed at camp. We are attending camp to get a job done, and must concentrate on it.

Students are not to leave camp at any time, for any reason without expressed permission of the Band Director. If you are given permission to leave camp, you must be signed out/in by an authorized parent/guardian with the Marching Band Camp Coordinator.

While at Marching Band Camp We are guests of the camp and are privileged to use their facilities. Individuals will be held responsible for any damage that occurs during Marching Band Camp.

- 6. Students must be on time to all rehearsals. Disciplinary action will be administered if necessary.
- 7. Students must attend **all** meals in the dining hall and they are required to eat at meals and drink plenty of water throughout the day. Please note: While eating meals, no mixing of leftovers or dumping salt, sugar, etc. No throwing of food will be permitted. No crushing/popping of plastic cups.
- 8. No students will be allowed outside of their assigned room from 10:30 pm 6:00 am without individual permission from the Band Director, Marching Band Camp Coordinator or Parent Chaperone. **Students are allowed in same gender rooms only**. Any student caught sneaking out at night or leaving camp premises will be immediately sent home which may result in dismissal from the DHS band program.
- 9. If you have a cell phone with you at camp it must remain in your room at all times. Cell phone usage shall not disturb other students after lights out. If you are found with your cell phone outside of your room or are using it at times other than designated it will be confiscated for the remainder of the week.
- 10. Portable stereo systems are allowed, but the volume must be at moderate levels. The parent chaperones have ultimate authority over volume levels and play selections.
